

Joyce Daze Blackberry Pie Contest

Judging

1. Judging begins at 11am sharp, Saturday.
2. Judges are chosen by the Joyce Daze Committee.
3. Pies will be judged for:
 - Overall appearance
 - Flavor, color, and texture of crust
 - Flavor, color, and texture of filling
 - Creativity
4. The judges' decision is final.
5. The winners will be announced immediately following the close of judging (approx 12 noon). Please return to the judging booth at that time.

Rules

1. Pie must be a traditional **two crust** berry pie. The berries must be the **native Pacific Blackberry** (*Rubus ursinus*).
2. Amateur bakers only. No professional bakers can enter this competition. (A professional is defined as someone who works for a bakery or sells pies).
3. Crusts and filling must be made from scratch. No store bought crust, dough or fillings may be used.
4. Pie must be prepared and baked by the individual submitting the pie for judging.
5. Pies are to be dropped off between 9am and 11am on Saturday, August 7 at the tent next to the Joyce Depot.
6. Youth entries must be 12 and under.
6. Entries will be assigned a number. Please complete entry information when submitting pie.
