Joyce, Washington- State Route 112

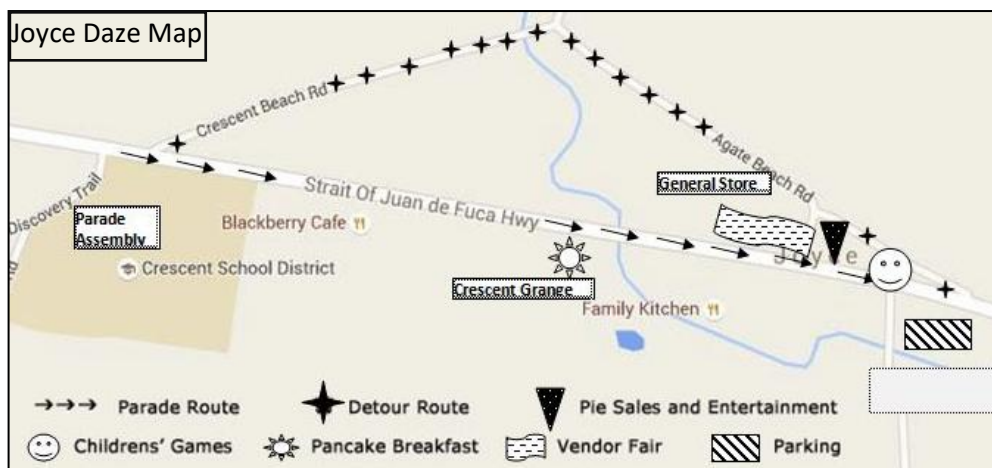
