Rules

- 1. Pie must be a traditional **two crust** berry pie. The berries must be the **native Pacific Blackberry** (Rubus ursinus).
- 2. Amateur bakers only. No professional bakers can enter this competition. (A professional is defined as someone who works for a bakery or sells pies).
- 3. Crusts and filling must be made from scratch. No store bought crust, dough or fillings may be used.
- 4. Pie must be prepared and baked by the individual submitting the pie for judging.
- 5. Pies are to be dropped off between 9am and 11am on Saturday, August 5 at the tent next to the Joyce Depot.
- 6. Youth entries must be 10-17 years old.
- 6. Entries will be assigned a number. Please complete entry information when submitting pie.
